# APPLICATION FOR TRAINING COURSES

### AGE GROUP REQUIREMENTS

The Club proposes the following minimum coaching requirements for each age group to ensure that there are sufficient qualified coaches in all age groups. The purpose of setting these standards is not only for the benefit of the children but also to assist the club in setting its annual budget for training and forward planning.

It should be noted that the coach qualification lasts for a term of three years after which it is necessary to repeat the course or take a higher-level certificate. The proposed minimum requirements are therefore those most appropriate for each group.

<b>U9</b>	1 Qualified Foundation Coaches 2 Level 1 Coaches  2 Qualified Referees at ELRA 1 & 2	One Level 1 Certificate to be taken in that season
<b>U10</b>	2 Level 1 Coaches  2 Qualified Referees at ELRA 1 & 2	
<b>U11 to U17</b>	2 Level 1 Coaches  2 Qualified Referees at ELRA 1 & 2	At U14 the Club will support a coach that wishes to progress to Level 2 Certificate

### PROCESS

Any parent that wishes to apply for a training course should have supported and assisted an age group coach consistently for a period of three months. An existing coach can apply for a course at any time.

The parent / coach must then complete the attached application form and obtain the approval and support from the head coach. The head coach will submit the application to the section Chairman and Training Coordinator for final authorisation.

Once approved the Training Coordinator will liaise with the candidate with regards to arranging dates with the necessary RFU body. Candidates will need to make payments for courses, other than those run by Guildfordians, directly but will be able to apply for a refund. Refunds will be made on receipt of a valid invoice and copy of the certificate.

In accepting a refund the coach is acknowledging that he / she will make a commitment to coach and support Guildfordians RFC for a minimum period of 12 months.
